ACICS Seeking Letter of Support from South Carolina Commission on Higher Education

## Ms. Goodwin,

This is Justin Nelson, I hope this message finds you well. I had the pleasure of speaking with Mr. Barton this afternoon and he mentioned that it would be best to get in touch with you on this matter.

Our legal team is reaching out to the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education on behalf of the Accrediting Council for Independent Colleges and Schools (ACICS). As you may be aware, ACICS accredits a variety of postsecondary institutions, many of whom operate in South Carolina or are approved by the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education. Currently ACICS is in the process of applying to the U.S. Department of Education (USDOE) for recognition as an institutional accreditor. As part of this process, ACICS is required to demonstrate that its role as an institutional accreditor is accepted by state licensing bodies.

To demonstrate this, we are hoping that the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education will join with other state licensing bodies in supporting ACICS by submitting a letter to the USDOE indicating that the Board accepts ACICS as a valid accreditor. If you have any time this week to discuss this matter it would be greatly appreciated, my schedule is flexible.
